The Bills are a duo of the coth and Bill Troiani, two American musicians who are based in Norway. Troiam plays bass and Booth guitar, fiddle and banjo with both supplying vocals. The only other musician is drummer Alexander Pettersen. Booth and Troiani are experienced musicians who have played in various bands and have performed together since 2012, but Til The Blues Have Gone is their debut studio album as a duo. The material is all original apart from the Son House cover Grinnin' In Your Face. As the album title suggests, the music is anchored in the blues but with touches of country, jazz and Gospel. There is a delightful smoothness to the album as their voices intertwine over soothing backings, but there is a lot of disguised detail that you can discern with a closer listen.
